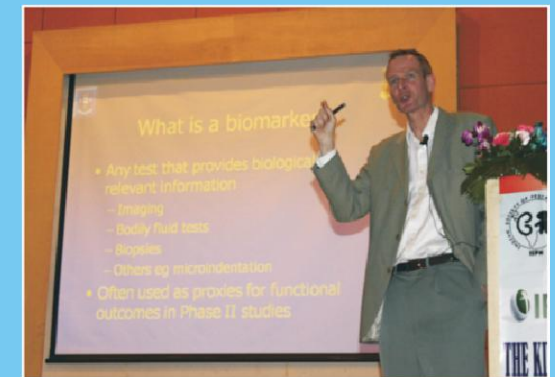

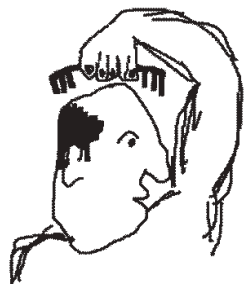

1. Oral biotin may reverse the alopecia induced by long term intake of sodium valproate.



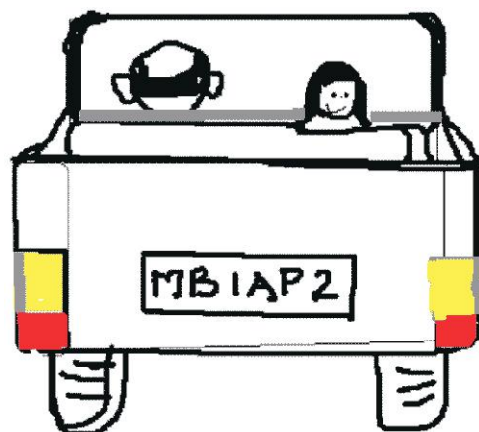
2. A newborn who feeds well from one breast and not from the other [the breast being normal] requires an examination to rule out a clavicular fracture.

A 3 day teaching course on 'Kidney bones and stones' was held from **29th November to 1st December 2012** at Textiles Committee Auditorium, Prabhadevi, Mumbai. The course was jointly organized by Mumbai Pediatric Nephrology Group, Indian Academy of Pediatrics Mumbai and Indian Society of Pediatric Nephrology.

It was supported by Indian society of Nephrology, Medical Council of India and Indian Council of Medical Research. The course was one of its kind on a topic which is not usually covered in conferences.

The faculty for the course consisted of stalwarts (eminent personalities) in the fields of Pediatric Nephrology and Pediatric Endocrinology.

The international faculty included Dr. Detlef Bockenhaur (Consultant Pediatric Nephrologist, Great Ormond street Hospital for children, London), Dr. Justine Bacchetta (Pediatric Nephrologist, Institut de Genomique Fonctionnelle, ENS Lyon, France), **Dr. Shaila Sukhtankar (Pediatric Nephrologist, Royal Manchester Childrens Hospital, UK)**, **Dr. Nick Bishop (Professor of Pediatric Bone disease, Sheffield Childrens hospital)**, **Dr. Zulf Mughal (Consultant Pediatric Bone disorders, Royal Manchester Childrens Hospital, UK)** and **Dr. Raja Padidela (Consultant Pediatric Endocrinologist, Royal Manchester**

Childrens Hospital, UK). The scientific program was meticulously designed covering all aspects of the subject by organizing chairperson

Dr. Uma Ali (Pediatric Nephrologist, Lilawati Hospital and B.J. Wadia Hospital for children).

Dr. Preeti Shanbag, Organizing chairperson of the course, welcomed all faculty and delegates and introduced the esteemed faculty. She presented an outline of the course and proposed vote of thanks. She thanked **Dr. Kumud Mehta, senior Pediatric Nephrologist** and Patron for the course, for her encouragement, support and advice. She also thanked all organizing Committee members for successful organization of the course. On the first day, 2 workshops were conducted. The first workshop in the morning session covered all aspects of renal tubular functions including tests for concentration and diluting capacity, proximal and distal tubular functions and ended with interactive case discussion. The second workshop on bones covered calcium and phosphorus metabolism, bone formation and resorption, bone biomarkers and bone densitometry. The faculty included Dr. Nick Bishop, **Dr. Zulf Mughal and Dr. Justine Bacchetta**.
