Dr Amin Kaba welcomed all the members.

Matters arising from the previous minutes of year 2018 AGM were discussed.

In the last AGM, it was discussed that there was a need for appointing a Returning Officer for the MBIAP elections announced in September every year. The election notice would first be sent to the Returning officer. The post would be for 2 years. The names of Dr Bharat Parekh and Dr Suhas Prabhu were proposed. Both were contacted telephonically. Dr Suhas Prabhu agreed to be the Returning officer.

IAP Mumbai had many members who were not yet members of Central IAP. A committee comprising of 2 seniors and 2 juniors would contact these members and help them get enrolled. The Committee would also look into updating the contact details of all its members. Presently IAP Mumbai members are 1150 in number. Increasing the number of members would give one more representation in the executive board of Central IAP. As per the constitution membership strength of 1250 entitled the branch for 3 EB members in central IAP. It was suggested that present strength of 1150 would be intimated to CIAP and request for increase in EB members to 2 posts from Mumbai, would be emailed. Dr. Bela Verma, Dr Amin Kaba, Dr. Yashwant Gabhale, Dr. Amruta Shirodkar and Dr. Nehal Shah would comprise the committee.

Dr. Dhiren Kalawadia suggested that MMC registration should be renewed. However it was pointed out that this wasn't compulsory.

Treasurer's report for year 2018 was presented by Dr. Yashwant Gabhale. Since IAP Mumbai had organized PEDICON 2019, Dr. Rajesh Chokani gave the report as the Treasurer of the Conference. The accounts would be kept in the office for one month, for any member wanting to peruse through them.

It was decided that an urgent meeting would be fixed with the CA, trustees and the OB to confirm the compliances and tax implications with the Charity Commissioner and the Income Tax department.

The board acknowledged the contribution of Dr Bipin Shah and Dr. Chokani for their dedication and hard work towards maintaining the financial records. Accounts were passed after being proposed by Dr. Tuteja and seconded by Dr. Manglani.

The board member were informed about the IMA and MAHAIAP awards which were received by the branch.

The work done by the branch in organizing the educational activities, PEDICON 2019 and EMBICON 2019 was appreciated by the board.

Dr Bela Verma introduced the matter regarding the trustee board. On reviewing the constitution it was noticed that the trustee board needed a long awaited review. One trustee would be replaced per year to comply with the constitution. Dr. Bharat Agarwal has offered to voluntarily step down and Dr. Pravin Mehta has been nominated for the vacated position.

The Board appreciated the services of Dr. Bharat Agarwal and a letter would to be sent to him thanking him and seeking his advisory support whenever required.

He would be felicitated at the next President installation function and the changed order would to be instituted through the Charity Commissioner's office. Mr. Amod Karandikar would be contacted for helping with the process.

Yearly report has to be sent to the Charity Commissioner regarding the annual change of OB members. The Trustees would review the finances quarterly.

Every month the record of finances should be sent to the OB and Trustees.

One Managing Trustee among the five would be elected by the Trustees and OB members. The Constitution would be reviewed and the points which are different from CIAP would be clarified. The board suggested to take a legal opinion regarding all the contentious points.

There was a brainstorming session regarding the charity work that could be done by the branch. Different aspects like adopting a village, community outreach activities and other activities were discussed.

Dr Bela Verma declared the results of the election. Dr. Vinay Joshi would be the President 2020, Dr. Sushma Save - the Secretary and Dr. Yashwant Gabhale would be the Treasurer.

The board acknowledged the contribution of the outgoing office bearers.

The board was informed about the working of the RAC. In the last financial year no one had applied for any study grant. A cap of Rs. 20000 per student (maximum of 10 proposals) for the research grant is to be continued.

Equipments for the office upgradation were approved.

Dr. Bipin Shah proposed a need for a proper MOU for collaboration with any Medical College/ Subspecialty Chapter /Organisation for the Educational activities. A draft of which would soon be presented to the board. The Terms and Conditions would be shared on the website.

The monthly CME of practicing Pediatricians would continue in IAP Mumbai office.

If IAP Mumbai members would like to hold Educational meetings, (not for CME/Workshop, not associated with any hospital and not supported by any Pharma) the hall would be free of any charges (with prior permission of OB members).

Dr. Sushma read out Dr. Vinay Joshi's message since he was unable to attend the meeting. He offered sincere apologies as he had given commitment to another conference 6 months ago. Dr Sushma presented Dr Joshi's plan of action which would be discussed in detail in the later meeting.

Dr. Uday Pai suggested that a projected annual budget should be presented in the meeting. An approximate figure of Rs 16 to 18 lakhs has been estimated to be the fixed expenses for the year.

It was suggested that the financial records should be presented earlier and then they could be passed in a meeting which should be held before 30th of September.

Dr. Uday Pai proposed the minutes, Dr. Bipin Shah seconded them and the minutes were passed.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks
